Balances as of the end of February:

Operating: \$177,986.77 Capital: \$120,133.60 Dam: \$3,697.71 Shared: \$177,154.44

Comments:

- 1. Current federal tax owed is \$18,698.
 - 1. We held back \$5,400 from the excess 2020 funds that went into the Shared Reserve based upon 2019's tax liability. This is not a 2021 expense. It is 2020
 - 2. We may have an opportunity to reduce this amount by writing off uncollectible accounts (to be discussed).
 - 3. Joe requested permission to move the difference between the final tax amount and \$5,400 from the Shared Reserve to the Operating Account to cover the tax obligation.
- 2. The treasure's report is draft pending completion of the Operating Account Bank Reconciliation. The reconciliation is open until we determine who bounced an electronic check through the online payment system.
- 3. Real estate tax payments have been made for the first two quarters of 2021.
