- Watson reviewed the plan for which roads are scheduled for upkeep this year and next
- Owner of Morris Asphalt and Watson spoke about the quality of materials that are available for the work. Unfortunately, double coating is now needed due to change in how product is produced
- Watson has a sign order in to replace signs that are down
- Hoping for Light winter again this coming year so we can do some more work like this again.

#### Enviro

- Scott thanked Cindy for reacting to problem quickly

#### **Beaches**

#### Entertainment

- Music on the Beach Friday night Sept 1
  - The quality materials we knew we wanted for the electrical work at the ballfield are finally in the electrician's hands. This took longer than idea but feel it was worth waiting for quality
  - o We should see work starting shortly
  - David understands they will be given permission to install large rocks in front of the service panel
  - Additional talk about large rocks to help with inappropriate car traffic on the grounds
- Kimberly Williams shared that Earl Parretti of South Shore is the owner of a renovation construction company out of Montclair who wants to be more involved in our community
- He is not ready to run for a position yet but wants to be put on a list for work programs that need attention

- Earl would be an excellent resource to Buildings and Grounds
- Kimberly also shared that she was approached by someone who inquired about skydiving and landing on Beach 3. This person said all they need is a letter of permission. Kimberly was surprised this would be all that is needed and wanted to bring it to the board
  - Scott shared concern about insurance
  - Q why Beach 3 and not the ball field? A not sure
  - Scott asked Kimberly for name and more information in an email to follow up with
- Sue shared Brian and Meeka Stolsenburg also do not want to run for a position, but want to be involved in our community. Suzanne shared that Grounds is an area where there is so much to be done.
  - IDEA Maybe Grounds is an area where there are subcommittees
  - The Board is looking to encourage Rob to delegate his working list of projects out to this growing list of interested volunteers

### President

- Scott reached out to Planet Networks to see how many people in PLA have reached out for contracts. He still has not received reply
  - Scott also inquired on if we do NOT meet the requirement that provides us free internet for our cameras, what will be our cost?
  - Scott is interested in getting internet at Beach 1 that is strong enough to reach the parking lot at the Ballfield so we can put a camera.
  - Scott asked for additional contacts other than Trish. Not getting back to us
  - A community member asked Scott about a dead ash tree on the edge of Edgewood and Northfield because it is in the right of way. Scott explained that just because we have the right of way does not mean we are responsible, it means we have the right to do the work if we deem
  - Scott suggested he and his neighbor partner on the tree Scott will keep us updated

- Tom to update the Board via email on his long term project (*Tom I could not hear the details via the audio clip Please help*)

#### New business

• Suzanne arranged for one of our community members to teach yoga this Saturday, and then alternating Saturdays and Sundays. She will do 4 sessions on Beach 1. Courtney will introduce her on Sat for Suzanne. This offer was put out to membership. Spread the word.

- Watershed community wants to share info at Membership meeting
  - Discussion on length of time needed
- Suzanne shared about a boating confrontation about a week ago. She described some
  reckless boating behavior that she and Vincent observed while out on their boat. They
  took on the act of letting the boaters know that they needed to be towing the children on
  the other side of the buoy. That boater erupted with very foul language in front of the
  children. Cindy asked for the boat number. Suzanne has a photo and boat number. Cindy
  will reach out to them.
  - Suzanne also received 2 or 3 emails about campers not following the rules
  - Meeting and email to campers and boaters. Suzanne wants to be a part of making this meeting happen
  - Kimberly shared that as a Board and engaged boating community, there is value in taking the lens that we all need to be reminded more often. We should expect frequent reminders to be given. We all need them!
  - Scott brough up the policy for personal behavior. Inquired if it was read and if there was feedback.
  - Scott explained the different levels of offense; first offense, second offense, etc
  - Scott will send the draft of the policy to the Board to vote on it. If approved by the Board, we can announce it at the annual meeting
  - Tom inquired if the Board has the right to assess fines. Discussion followed. Scott will double check his email from Donna Shaw (lawyer)
