In order to keep your septic running correctly, it is suggested that houses that end in even numbers (ex: 2,4,6,8,0) have their septic pumped this year. Also consider using a rain barrel at your home to collect water which can be used around your property. Instead of fertilizers, consider using lime.

BOATING:

If you are on your boat, canoe, kayak or paddleboard before May 1st, you must wear a US Coast Guard approved life jacket. It is a law that came into effect last year.

These documents need to be with you when using your boat:

Boat registration

Drivers License with your boating endorsement on it

Your boat safety card

The Marine Division of the State Police can come on our lake at any time, so remember to have the above documents with you.
